Sunday, December 31 10 am -Holy Innocents worship service. *These young boys killed by Herod were innocent of any crime, except that one of them might take over Herod's throne. The Holy Innocents did not know Jesus, but they died in his place. They are remembered by the church because of the circumstances of their death. Joseph was told by God to take the child Jesus and his mother and flee into Egypt because Herod planned to kill all first born baby boys in Bethlehem. Their feast day is December 28. At our service this Sunday, we will remember all the Holy Innocents; children that are being killed during our time due to wars and violence of which they have no part other than to be living in a land torn by war and violence. We pray and remember the Holy Innocents of today. The church gives us this feast day as a time to reflect on the sadness of the loss of so many very young and innocent lives through no fault of their own.*
